- Achieve zero incidents of forced labour or child labour identified within our direct supply chain.

This Sustainable Procurement Policy will be integrated into our company's internal systems, supplier selection processes, and contract management procedures. We will:

- Develop clear guidelines and tools for procurement teams to assess and select suppliers based on environmental and social performance.
- Provide ongoing training and capacity building for our procurement professionals.
- Engage suppliers through various mechanisms, including assessments, audits, and collaborative improvement programs.
- Consistently evaluate, monitor, and address environmental and social risks in our supply chain through due diligence and active supplier engagement.
